E CHAPEL ST

THE BELLE ISLE: great bar and restaurant for a night out

Turn around and retrace your steps back to the Market Cross, turn right onto South Street

F SOUTH ST

SOLUTIONS INC: for everything Apple
PERFECT TIMING: long established for timepieces and jewellery
CRUMBS AND CREAMS: classic tearoom right in the centre
JABA YARD: clothing for women and children, accessories, gifts, homeware
SMITH & RALLIER: quality and experienced jewellers
TIMOTHY ROE FINE JEWELLERY: bespoke pieces
ZIGZAG: shoes galore, very popular store
REAL BURGER KITCHEN: open all day every day
PALERMO: women's fashion

Head back towards the Cross. Turn right on to East Street

G EAST STREET

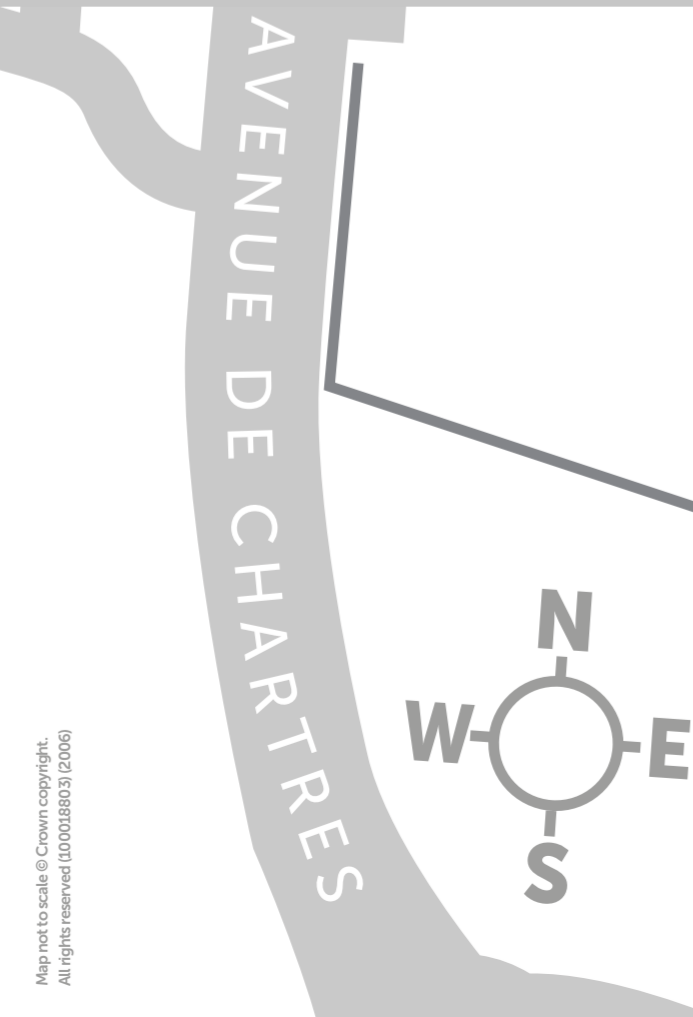

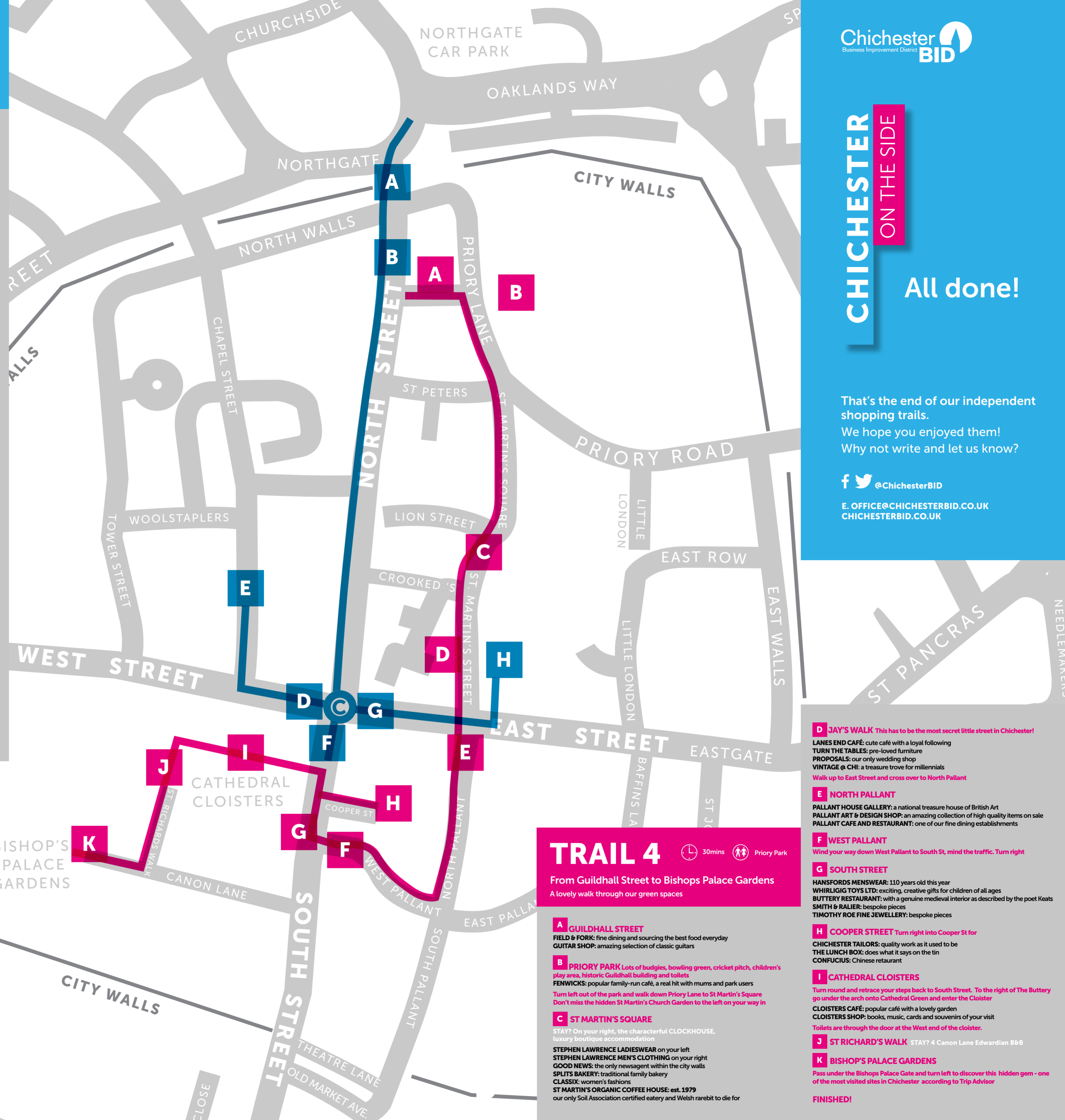

From Guildhall Street to Bishops Palace Gardens
A lovely walk through our green spaces

A GUILDHALL STREET

FIELD & FORK: fine dining and sourcing the best food everyday
GUITAR SHOP: amazing selection of classic guitars

B PRIORY PARK

Lots of budgies, bowling green, cricket pitch, children's play area, historic Guildhall building and toilets
FENWICKS: popular family-run café, a real hit with mums and park users
 Turn left out of the park and walk down Priory Lane to St Martin's Square
 Don't miss the hidden St Martin's Church Garden to the left on your way in

C ST MARTIN'S SQUARE

STAY? On your right, the characterful CLOCKHOUSE, luxury boutique accommodation

STEPHEN LAWRENCE LADIESWEAR on your left
STEPHEN LAWRENCE MEN'S CLOTHING on your right
GOOD NEWS: the only newagent within the city walls
SPLITS BAKERY: traditional family bakery
CLASSIX: women's fashions
ST MARTIN'S ORGANIC COFFEE HOUSE: est. 1979
 our only Soil Association certified eatery and Welsh rarebit to die for

D JAY'S WALK

This has to be the most secret little street in Chichester!
LANES END CAFÉ: cute café with a loyal following
TURN THE TABLES: pre-loved furniture
PROPOSALS: our only wedding shop
VINTAGE @ CHI: a treasure trove for millennials
 Walk up to East Street and cross over to North Pallant

E NORTH PALLANT

PALLANT HOUSE GALLERY: a national treasure house of British Art
PALLANT ART & DESIGN SHOP: an amazing collection of high quality items on sale
PALLANT CAFE AND RESTAURANT: one of our fine dining establishments

F WEST PALLANT

Wind your way down West Pallant to South St, mind the traffic. Turn right

G SOUTH STREET

HANSFORDS MENSWEAR: 110 years old this year
WHIRLIGIG TOYS LTD: exciting, creative gifts for children of all ages
BUTTERY RESTAURANT: with a genuine medieval interior as described by the poet Keats
SMITH & RALLIER: bespoke pieces
TIMOTHY ROE FINE JEWELLERY: bespoke pieces

H COOPER STREET

Turn right into Cooper St for
CHICHESTER TAILORS: quality work as it used to be
THE LUNCH BOX: does what it says on the tin
CONFUCIUS: Chinese restaurant

I CATHEDRAL CLOISTERS

Turn round and retrace your steps back to South Street. To the right of The Buttery go under the arch onto Cathedral Green and enter the Cloister
CLOISTERS CAFÉ: popular café with a lovely garden
CLOISTERS SHOP: books, music, cards and souvenirs of your visit
 Toilets are through the door at the West end of the cloister.

J ST RICHARD'S WALK

STAY? 4 Canon Lane Edwardian B&B

K BISHOP'S PALACE GARDENS

Pass under the Bishops Palace Gate and turn left to discover this hidden gem - one of the most visited sites in Chichester according to Trip Advisor

TRAIL 1

30mins Train Station Ave. De Chartres Car Park

From Bus & Train Stations to The Hornet
30 minutes. Parking and toilets at train station or Avenue de Chartres multi-storey

A BUS & TRAIN STATIONS

Like most station quarters you'll find useful outlets here
H & M COFFEE: and newspapers on Platform One
THE CAFE THE STATION: on Platform Two
At the bus station -

B SOUTHGATE

The south end of South St is Chichester's biggest eating and drinking quarter

ISLAND FINE ARTS: gallery with original works for sale
SANTORINI: Greek and Mediterranean restaurant
THE SWEET JAR: classic old-fashioned sweet shop
THE VESTRY: our only (very) late night license with rooms upstairs. STAY?
ARTIES KITCHEN: authentic Spanish tapas
LUCKY HOUSE: Chinese take-out
ROCKING HORSE: a genuine micro cocktail bar
FOXWOOD WEDDING CAKES: all you need for that special day
SHAKE-A-DELIC: dessert bar – milkshakes, frozen yoghurt, smoothies...
DRAPEWEL INTERIORS: soft furnishings and attentive personal service

C COURTYARD

Cathedral Courtyard marks the transition from Southgate to South Street where you will find

KIM'S BOOKSHOP: a wide second hand book selection with some choice post cards on sale
PRESENT SURPRISE: a well-stocked gift shop
CHESCA: women's fashion boutique
THE WEBB STREET COMPANY: great ideas for interiors
EBONY JEWELLERS: beautiful antique and new pieces
ANALOGUE RECORDS: all the rage now that vinyl is back
HANSFORDS MENSWEAR: 110 years old this year

E WEST PALLANT

Take a right off South St onto West Pallant, wind your way down until you reach the
PALLANT HOUSE GALLERY: a national treasure house of British Art
PALLANT BOOK SHOP: the best art and design books for miles around
PALLANT CAFE AND RESTAURANT: one of our fine dining establishments
Continue along East Pallant past the District Council Offices.
Don't miss straight ahead
CLAUDINE ICKERINGILL: for superior eye-care

F BAFFINS LANE

Turn left into Baffins Lane and dive into Baffins Court, the former yard to The Fleece coaching inn, where you will find
THE SERIOUS SANDWICH: a friendly family café and takeout popular with office workers
WHITBY'S PHOTO-IMAGING: our only independent imaging shop
Come back out into Baffins Lane for
INDIGO: premier women's fashion boutique
Proceed to the end of Baffins Lane

G EAST STREET

Turn right into East St for
PHONE IN: for all your mobile needs
THE REAL EATING COMPANY: café and restaurant
CRISPINS: the only Americano in Chi served the way the Italians like it
HARRINGTONS LEATHER GOODS: our only indie dedicated to leather goods
AMOeba JEWELLERS: great service for your jewellery needs
JOHNSTONS ELECTRICAL: a proper white goods store like every city used to have

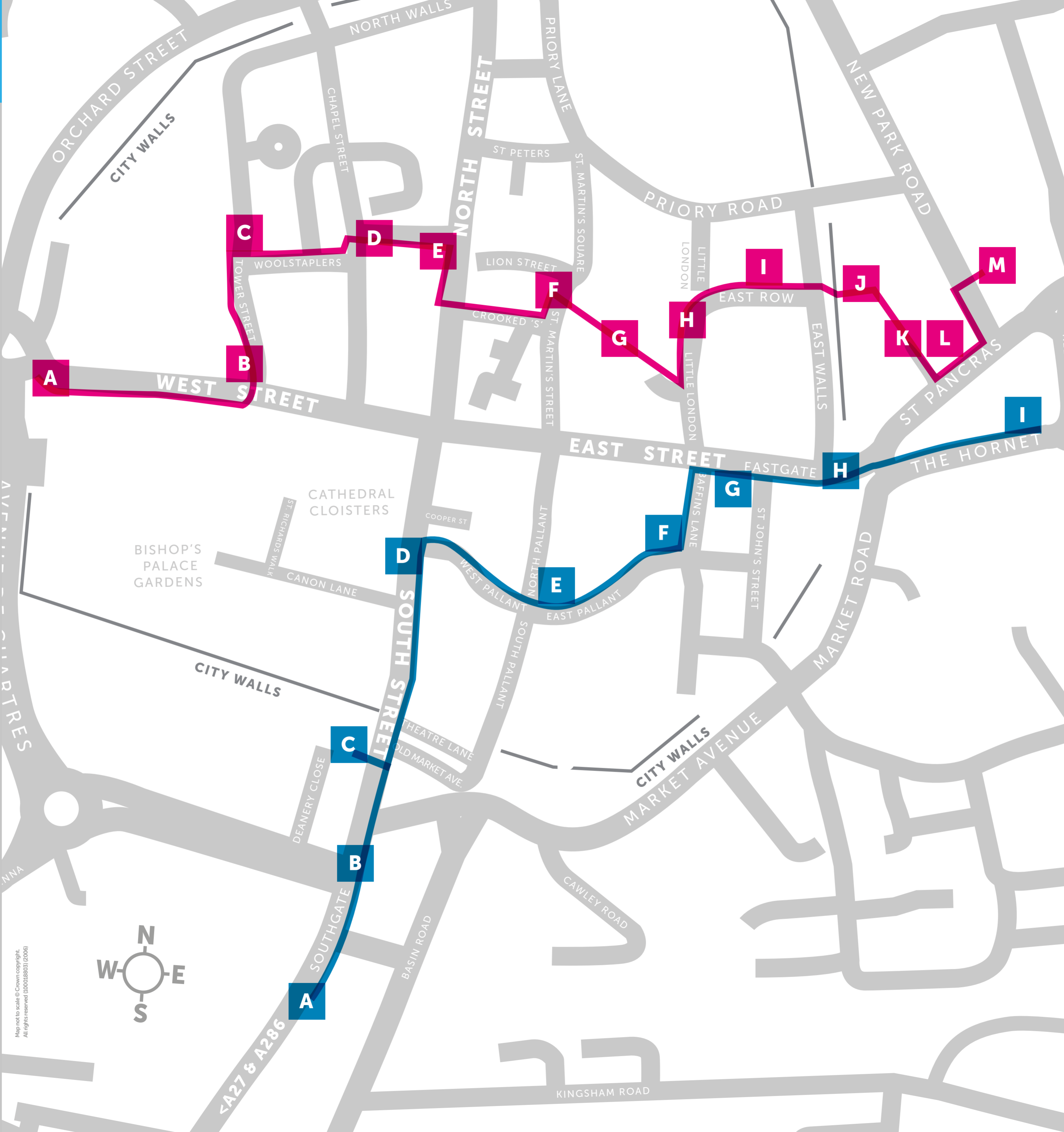
H EASTGATE SQUARE

Keats stayed here so why not sit with him on the bench for a while? Eastgate Sq and nearby streets have our biggest concentration of inlets. Toilets and car park in Market Avenue to the right

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TRAIL 2

30mins

From West St to Litten Gardens
A 30 minute Roman street adventure. Parking in Orchard St. Toilets in Tower St. and Market Avenue

A WEST STREET

Start at the top of West St by the Westgate roundabout
THE OLD COTTAGE RESTAURANT: Indian, spot the West Gate hinge at the Roman city entrance
THE CHICHESTER INN: real ale, world music, food and B&B. STAY?
HANCOCK ANTIQUES: long, long established, great curios
ACKERMAN MUSIC: everything for the musical person
CHICHESTER ARMOURY: for those country pursuits
THE RICHARD TILDESLEY PRACTICE: superior specs, est. 1965

B TOWER STREET

Turn left into Tower St. Toilets nearby
Discover the Roman baths in the Novium, opposite the County Library which is one of the few 20th century buildings listed in Chichester

C WOOLSTAPLERS

Follow round into the Woolstaplers. A big hint as to how Chichester grew to be rich and able to build our splendid Georgian backdrop

D CRANE STREET

A quick left and right into Crane Street
LIBERTÉ BOUTIQUE: women's fashion
SPIRES BAKERY & COFFEE SHOP: family business making everything fresh every day
SKE SERVICES: reliable shoe repairs
PREVIEW BOUTIQUE: women's fashion

E NORTH STREET

Turn right into North St. Look out for the Roman remains under the arches of the Council House

CLOUD GALLERY: for modern art
THE COLN GALLERY: the painter's paradise
LUCKES: popular well-being café
BETWEEN THE LINES: quality gift shop

F ST MARTIN'S SQUARE

Turn left off North Street and head down the Crooked 'S' twnen and enter St Martin's Square
SPLITS BAKERY: traditional family bakery
GOOD NEWS: hard-working family run, quality newsagent
STEPHEN LAWRENCE MEN'S CLOTHING: timeless classics
STEPHEN LAWRENCE LADIESWEAR: always something new for the discerning lady

Look down St Martin's St -
CLASSIX - the second of their 2 Chichester shops (see Walk 3 for the other): women's fashion
ST MARTIN'S ORGANIC COFFEE HOUSE: approved by the Soil Association, est. 1979

G LITTLE LONDON CAR PARK

Cross St Martins Square into the M65 car park. 12th century St Mary's Hospital on your left, superior toilets to your right. On the far side you will find Little London

H LITTLE LONDON

Look out for the Roman remains left and mosaic floor on the right as you enter
COMMON GROUNDS: new coffee kid on the block
LA HAVANA: our only jazz club, open mic Weds, private functions
LITTLE LONDON BOUTIQUE: premier women's fashion with a loyal clientele
LITTLE LONDON TEA ROOMS: a classic Chichester tearoom
Turn left at La Havana

I EAST ROW

Turn right at the end into East Row
FOUNDER OF ADELAIDE PLAQUE: the Quaker pioneer John Hack a founder of Adelaide, Australia lived here 1805-27
SCULPTURE ON CORNER: The Symbol of Discovery, 1963 by John Skelton
STAY? Book a bed for the night at the newly refurbished EAST WALLS HOTEL

J NEW PARK

Cross under the walls by the Cadet Drill Hall, then a quick right and left down Keats Way to discover on your left
THE CHICHESTER CINEMA AT NEW PARK: our very own art cinema showing hundreds of films a year and home to the Chichester Film Festival

K CHURCH SQUARE

Cross the New Park car park to enter Church Square via Richmond House. Look out for the modern sculpture 'Nurture' by Lawson Baker on the right
ART FOR ALL GALLERY: accessible, affordable art

L ST PANCRAS

Emerge onto St Pancras by the church and turn left
Toilets opposite in Market Ave.

GUITAR SOUND: one of our few musical instrument shops
THE NAGS HEAD: classic pub with a legendary carvery
MASALA CITY: enjoy authentic Indian food
INDIA GATE: fresh authentic Indian cuisine
ART STUDIO: original ceramics
CHABA THAI: fresh authentic Thai food
BOND-A-FRAME great personal service, quality workmanship

M LITTEN GARDENS

Cross to Litten Gardens at the lights, a cemetery since the 3rd century and now the home of our war memorial in this WW1 centenary year
Nearest car park is New Park
